Overview

Add a rider to the bill pattern for the Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to require the allocation of \$125.0 million from any available source of funds to provide grants to counties for transportation infrastructure projects located in areas of the state affected by increased oil and gas production as stipulated in Subchapter C, Chapter 256, Transportation Code.

Required Action

Add the following rider to the bill pattern for the Department of Transportation:

- **Transportation Infrastructure Fund.** Out of amounts appropriated above to the Department of Transportation, \$125,000,000 from any available source of revenue shall be allocated to provide grants for transportation infrastructure projects under Subchapter C, Chapter 256, Transportation Code.
