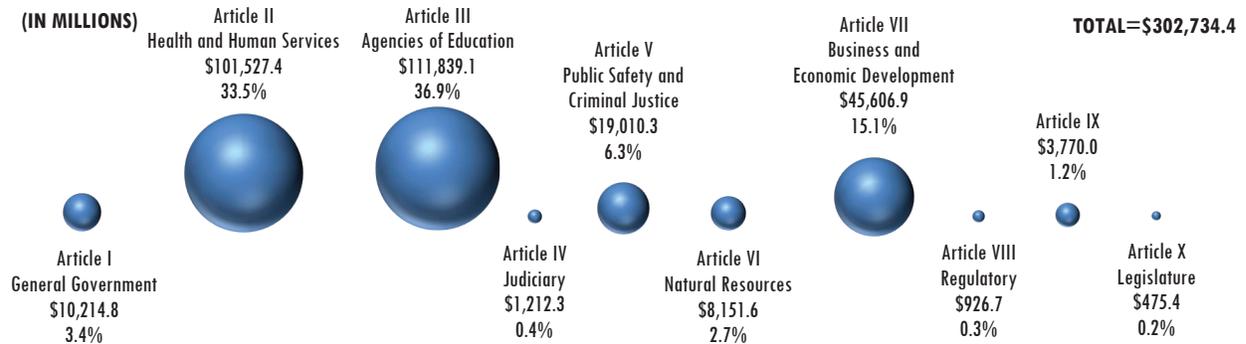

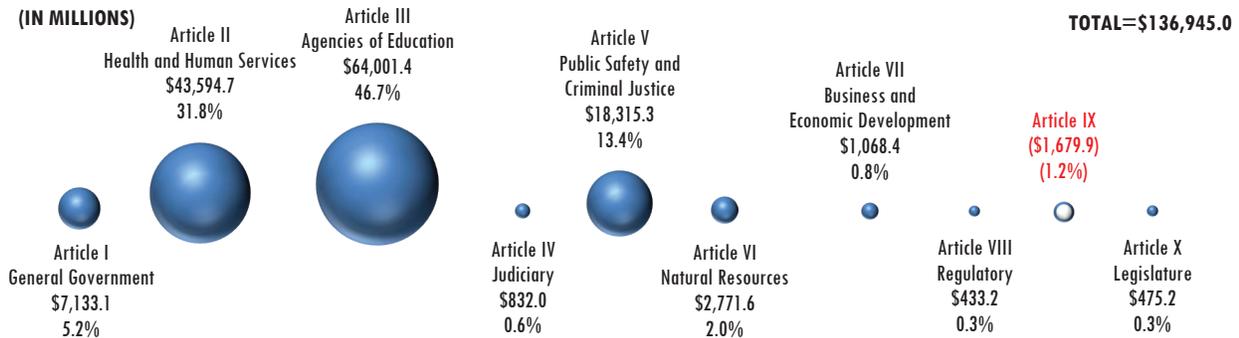

FUNDING BY ARTICLE, GENERAL REVENUE FUNDS**

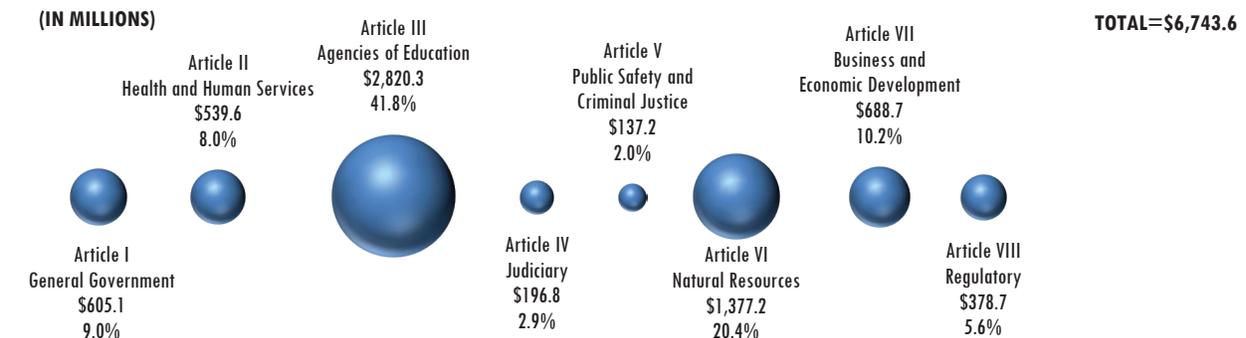

FUNDING BY ARTICLE, GENERAL REVENUE–DEDICATED FUNDS**

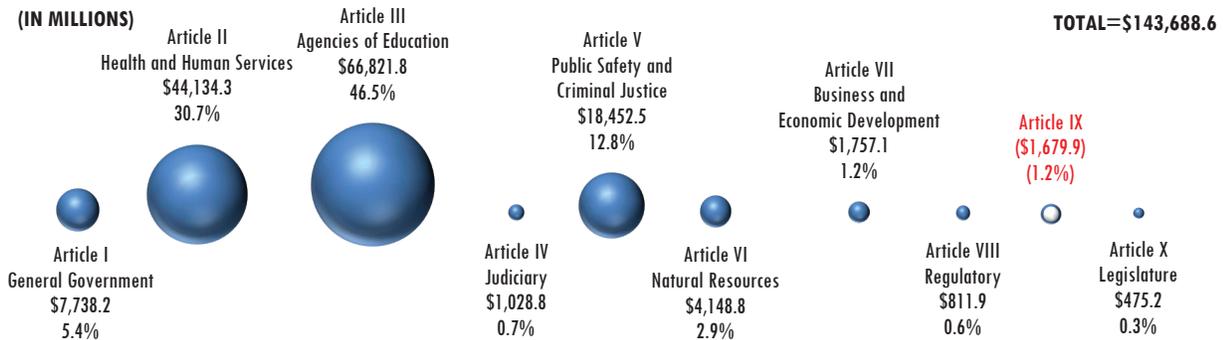

FUNDING BY ARTICLE, GENERAL REVENUE FUNDS AND GENERAL REVENUE–DEDICATED FUNDS

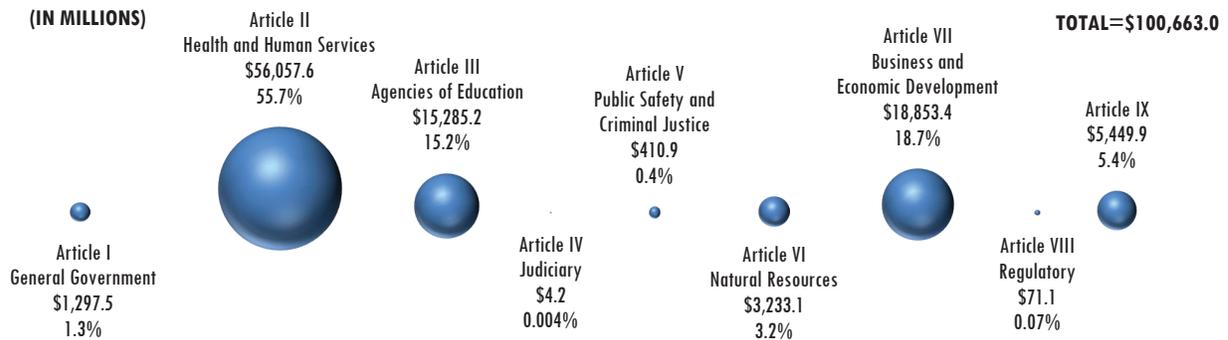

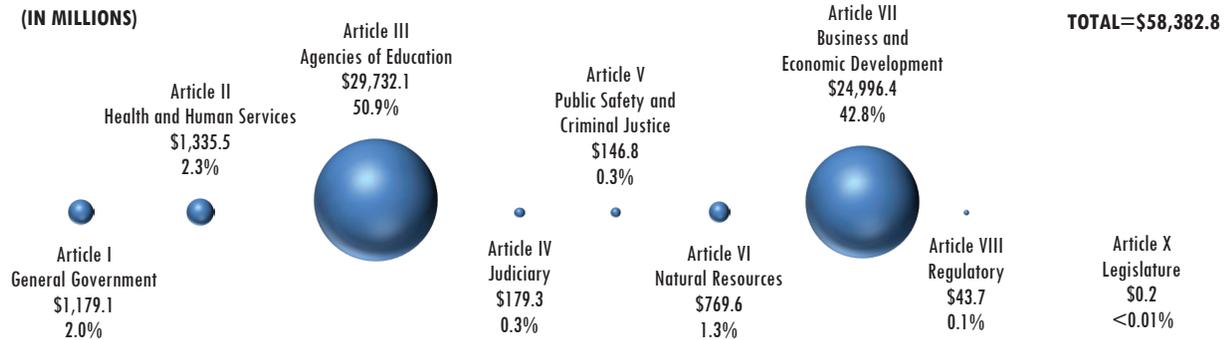

FUNDING BY ARTICLE, OTHER FUNDS**



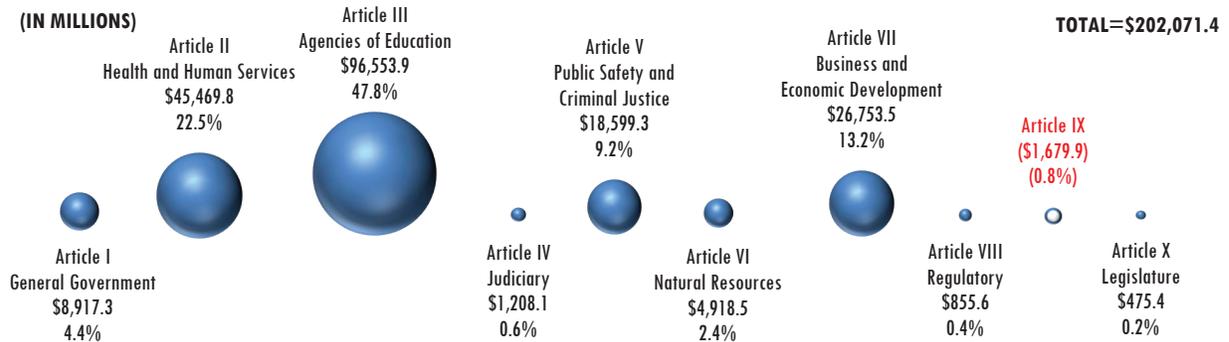
